

## PE Curriculum - Term 4

During this term the children will be participating in a range of net and wall games activities.

They will develop skills needed to successfully participate in games which require propelling a ball or similar object into a space over a barrier, such as a net, or against a wall. They will learn to direct an object into a court or at a target and away from an opponent.

In all games activities, children have to think about who they use skills, strategies and tactics. They will begin with the foundations of net/wall activities and move on to more complex games. They will learn to transfer throwing and catching skills they learn in net games to other types of game.



Children will develop basic racket skills, choose and use tactics to defend and attack, adapt and refine rules, make up their own games, use rules fairly and be able to explain how they may improve their own performance.
