

Term 3 - Winter Wonderland!



In Year 3 & 4 we are continuing to explore different climates throughout our Winter Wonderland topic. Our English lessons will be inspired by Hans Christian Andersen's classic fairytale: The Snow Queen which will continue to influence our Science and Geography lessons through learning about countries with colder climates which also have key physical features of volcanoes and earthquakes. We will examine and compare the habitats of animals in this country and in those with lower temperatures.

Our key focus in Maths this term is multiplication and division as it has become apparent this is an area where some children lack confidence.

Term 4 - Revolting Romans!



This term will be History-led as we learn about the rulers and invaders in Britain and how life was altered when the Romans invaded. We will also have a Roman feast day where we can all dress up and learn more about the Roman way of life. We will at a range of historically relevant texts in English to include: short stories, myths and legends, poetry and non-fiction. Art was a prominent aspect of Roman culture therefore we will be creating our own mosaics and Roman inspired pieces.

Our key focus in Maths this term is fractions, decimals and percentages where we will focus on real life application.
